Unable to prescribe DEA controlled medications (i.e. ADHD stimulant medications and anti-anxiety benzodiazepines), detox medications (i.e. Suboxone, Methadone), medications that have the potential for abuse (i.e. pseudoephedrine, some muscle relaxants), sleep medications, or medicinal marijuana.
